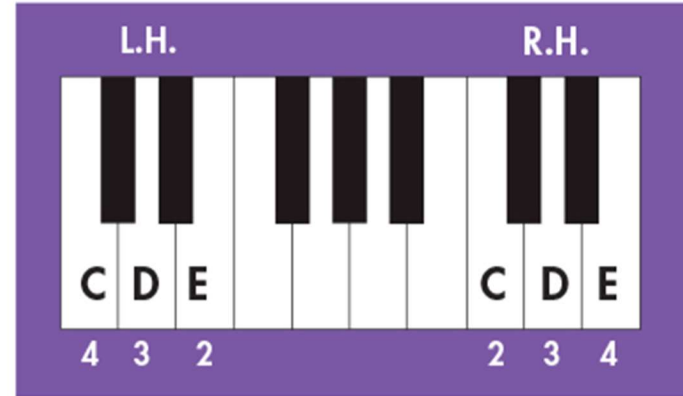


# Little Lost Kitty

1. Point to each note, counting "1, 1, 1, 1."  
Use **L.H.** for *down*-stems and **R.H.** for *up*-stems.
2. Guide your teacher! Point to each note and say the **finger number** as your teacher plays.
3. Circle all the **repeated notes**.
4. Play on the piano, singing the finger numbers.
