

# Middle C for Bass Clef

Pretend the bass clef is the King.  
Can you find the two buttons popping off his chest?

The king has a cat named **Middle C Cat**.  
Find the "whisker" line in the face of Middle C Cat on the throne.

## Tips from King Bass Clef:

1. Make Middle C Cat "purr" by gently tickling the Middle C key with L.H. finger 2, then 3, then 1.
2. Now watch your teacher play the piece. Your turn! Make Middle C Cat jump to your thumb at the end.



## 5 The King's Cat

Cheerfully  
repeated notes

Repeat *p* (piano).
