

Middle C for Treble Clef

Pretend the treble clef is the Queen with a long swirly dress.
The Queen also adores her cat, **Middle C**.

Tips from Queen Treble Clef:

1. Make Middle C Cat "purr" by gently tickling the Middle C key with **R.H. finger 2**, then **3**, then **1**.
2. Now watch your teacher play the piece. Your turn!
Make Middle C Cat jump to your thumb at the end.
