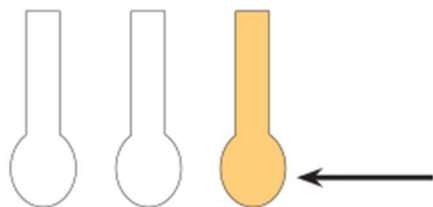


Damper Pedal



The right foot pedal is called the **damper pedal**.*

When we press it, the sound rings! You or your teacher may press the damper pedal down for the entire song. Listen to the sound!
