**Marching Feet:**

1. First, as your teacher plays, you march in place with a **HALF NOTE BEAT**. Your teacher will start you off by saying, "Left, Right," etc.
2. Now you play. You're the leader of the band when your teacher can march in place to **YOUR** steady beat!

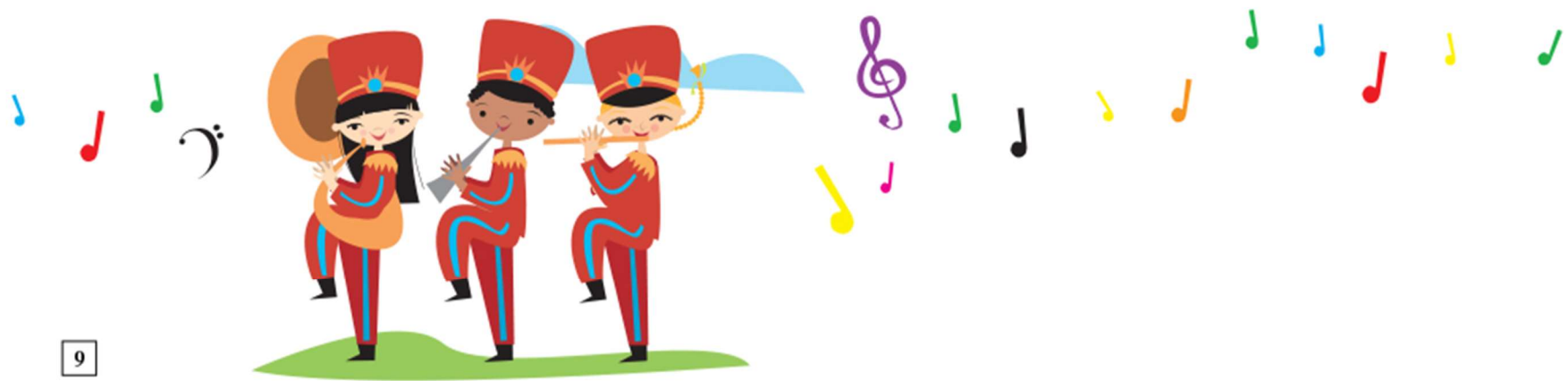
