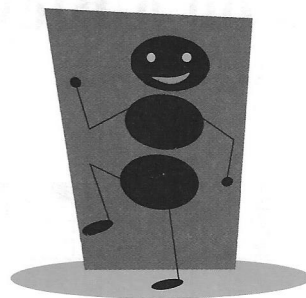
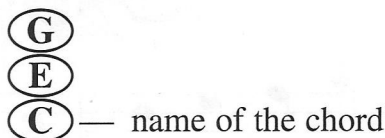


# The C Chord

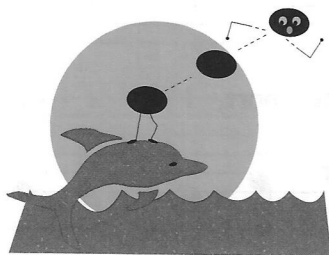
