


# Transposing

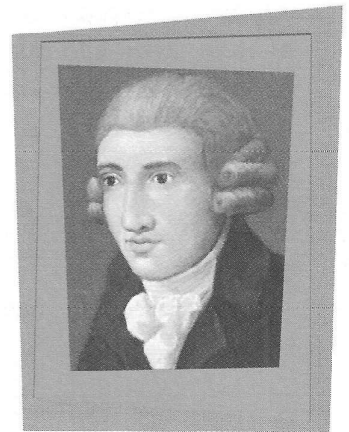
Playing the same piece using a different scale is called *transposing*. The note names change, but the **intervals** stay the same.
