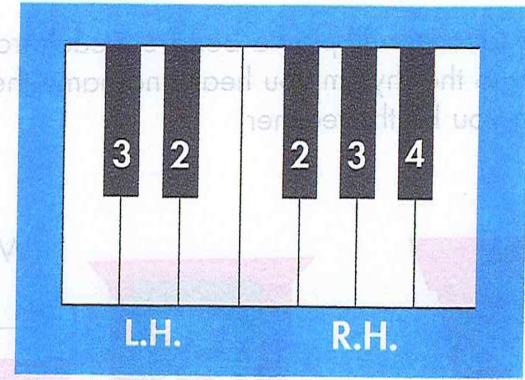

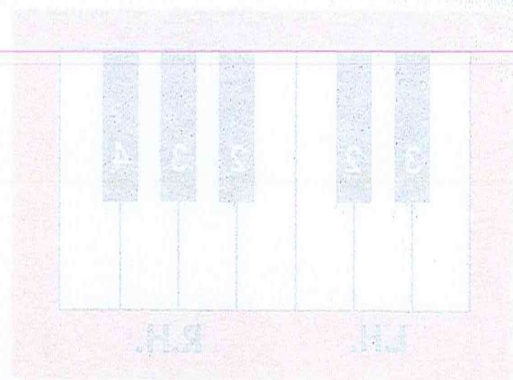

4. Have fun tapping *I Feel Rhythm* in your Writing Book, pp. 42–43.



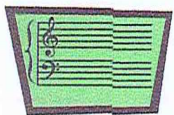
