

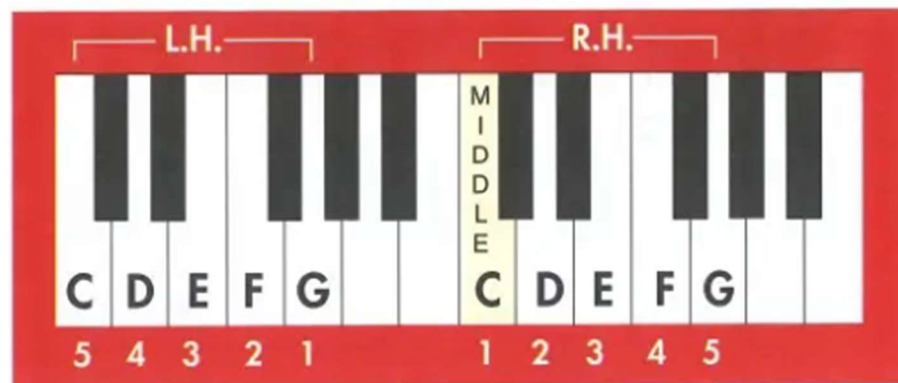
### Tips from the friends:

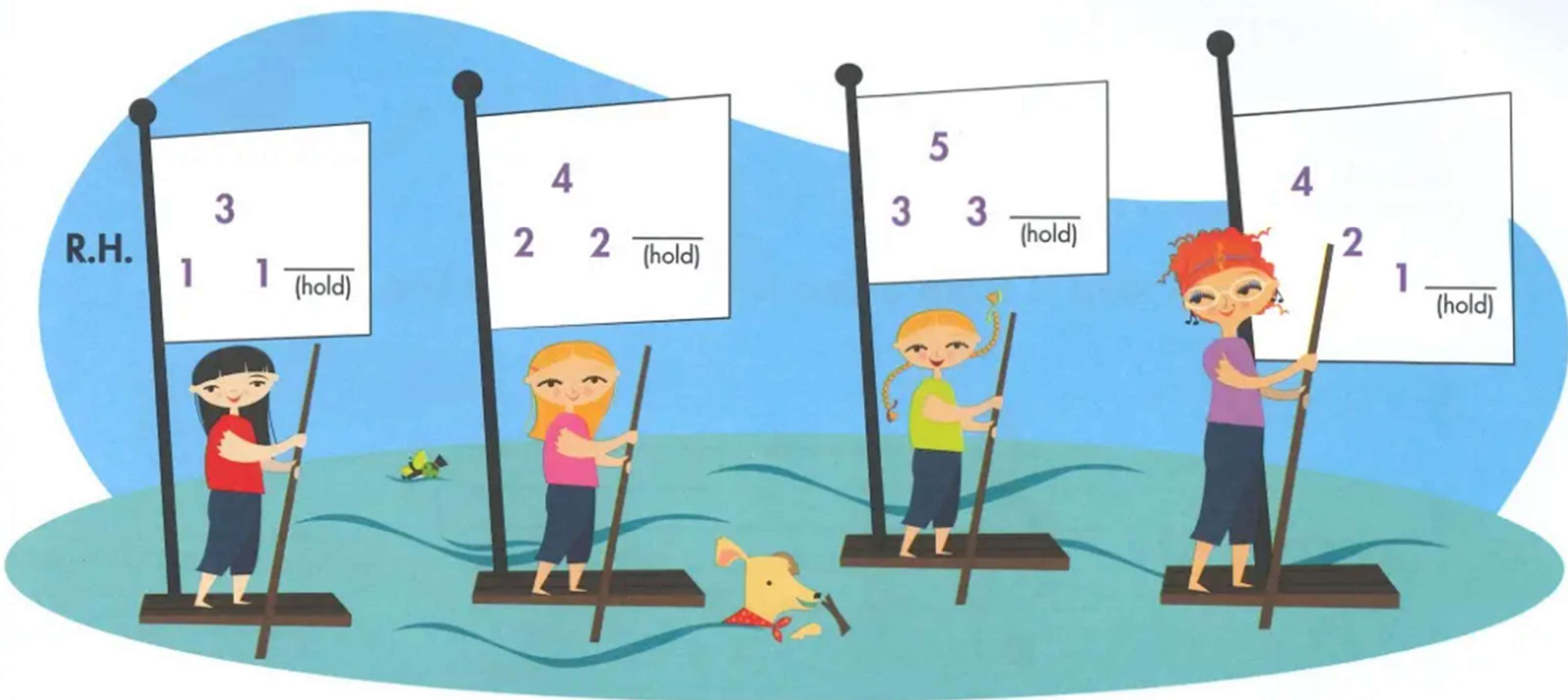
