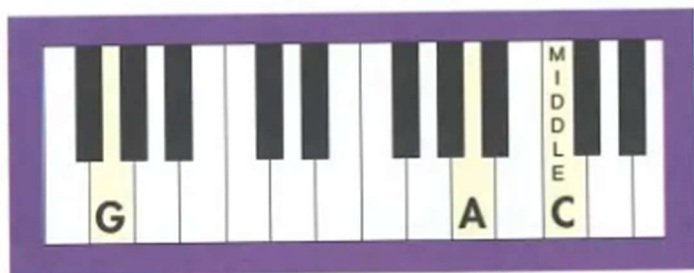


Tips from Mrs. Razzle-Dazzle:
