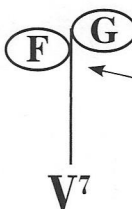
The V⁷ Chord



V is the Roman numeral for the number 5.

The **V⁷ chord** (pronounced “five-seven”) is a 4-note chord.

In this book, a simplified 2-note version of the V⁷ chord is used.

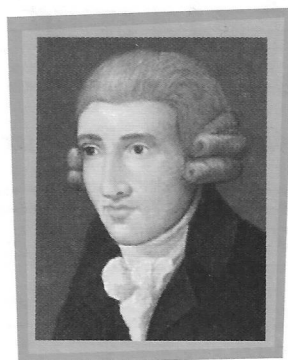
