

Jazz Blast Improvisation

Improvise means to make up "on the spot."

You are ready to improvise your own cool sounds for Jazz Blast. Here's how:





- 1. Use the C minor 5-finger scale, plus cross over to B^{\(\beta\)}! Play the keys in any order.
- 2. To start, set your R.H. over the keys and let your teacher begin. Feel the beat before you start playing.
- 3. Hint: Play lots of repeated notes, experiment with steps and skips, and play a few very l-o-n-g notes.
- 4. When your teacher says, "Now go back to *Jazz Blast*," play *Jazz Blast* on page 54 once again to end.
