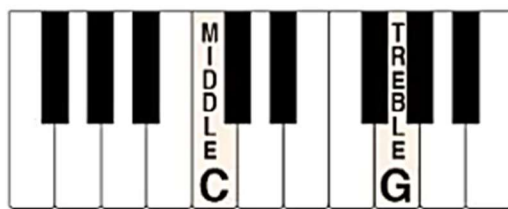


Learning Treble G
