

### Woodwind Ear Training Exam – Level 3

Note: All musical examples will be played two times.

1. **Scales** – You will hear a scale. Circle the type of scale that matches the example you hear.

(3 points total / 1 point each)

3. **Intervals** – You will hear an interval. Circle A or B below next to the interval that matches the example you hear. (2 points total / 1 point each)

Example 2:      A. 4<sup>th</sup>      B. 7<sup>th</sup>

4. **Intonation** – You will hear two pitches on the same note. Is the 2<sup>nd</sup> pitch flat or sharp?
