REPERTOIRE/EVALUATOR REMARKS:

1. Sonata in B minor, K. 87/L. 33 by D. Scarlatti Expressive tempo. You voiced the tops pretty well, but I would a bit more on holding the tied and long notes full value. I know that can be very tricky in Baroque music. You did hold many of them, but it would be a little smoother and more rich if all the notes were held. In places, especially with a slower tempo like this, you could experiment with touches of pedal to warm up arpeggiated chords or held smooth a tricky place to connect. Fine work overall. 2. Rondo Alla Turca, III. Allegretto from Sonata in A, K. 331 by W.A. Mozart Nice clear dynamic contrasts. In the first line, try to lift the RH so we hear the eighth rests. In the A major section, make sure each LH chord roll is clear. Use a bit more wrist with a small angling toward the pinky to help the eighth note ones. Consider using a touch of pedal on each one. Excellent clarity and consistent tempo. Fine ending!	Memorized: ✓ Yes	□ No
3. Consolation No. 5, S. 172 by F. Liszt Very expressive rubato. You breathe well between section and phrases. Overall the RH melody was well shaped and voiced. Hold the pedal a bit longer when the LH has a roll, like m. 19. The voicing of the melody became trickier from m. 38 to the end. The melody need more projection there. Work a bit more to secure the ending lines. You sounded hesitant and the rubato made the rhythm incorrect in places, (m. 45 and 58). You have a great feel for the Romantic style. 4. Rialto Ripples by G. Gershwin Fine tempo choice. I would avoid swinging the eighths - 1. Rag style generally does not swing. 2. You would need to be more consistent with the swing (you did swing for m. 1-11 and similar spots, but not the rest) Check RH notes in m 17 and both hands in m. 47 for accuracy.
